

BEST workers warn of protest over demands

With the three-month deadline set by the Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport (BEST) administration nearing, employees are preparing for renewed agitation over a host of long-pending demands. The BEST workers' union has called a meeting on February 17 at Kashinath Dhuru Hall to decide the course of action.

Earlier, the union had withdrawn an indefinite hunger strike after the administration assured negotiations and positive decisions within three

Key unresolved demands include the implementation of the Seventh Pay Commission recommendations, salary parity with the BMC employees, promotions, filling of vacant posts, settlement of final dues and employment on compassionate grounds.

The union has also demanded immediate payment of gratuity to retired employees and better financial planning.

3 brain-dead donors give life to 24 patients

Organ donation by three brain-dead patients in Mumbai and Navi Mumbai last week has given a new lease on life to more than two dozen critically ill patients. While some were saved through liver transplants, others received kidneys, and many regained their eyesight through cornea transplants.

According to the Zonal Transplant Coordination Committee (ZTCC), three patients were declared brain-dead on Saturday at Raheja Hospital in Mahim, Fortis Hospital in Navi Mumbai, and Hira Mongi Navneet Hospital in Mulund. The families made a courageous decision and consented to organ donation.

At Raheja Hospital, with the consent of the family of a 53-year-old brain-dead man, his kidneys were donated. At Fortis Hospital, organ donation from a 70-year-old brain-dead patient made it possible to transplant a liver, kidneys, tissues, and corneas into several needy patients. Similarly, at Hira Mongi Navneet Hospital, a 48-year-old brain-dead patient's liver, kidneys, skin, and corneas were donated.

Experts say that such timely decisions not only prove life-saving for patients but also strengthen awareness and positive thinking about organ donation in society. The medical community believes that if more such examples come forward, the long waiting lists for organ transplants can be significantly reduced.

No locus standi: NCLT bins petition against UCNITA

The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) has dismissed a petition filed by Yohan Gulab Immanuel, Arun Kumar Rai and others (petitioners), which raised grievances relating to the membership and management of the United Church of Northern India Trust Association (UCNITA). The tribunal noted that the FIR registered against the petitioners indicated mala fide intent.

The order recorded that the petitioners are not members of UCNITA within the meaning of Section 2(55) of the Companies Act and, consequently, lack the requisite locus standi to maintain a petition under the Companies Act, which permit members to approach the NCLT in cases of oppression and mismanagement.

The petition was filed for alleged illegal continuation of directors, wrongful induction of members, and unauthorised alienation of UCNITA's properties. The petitioners claimed they were elected members and directors of the trust association and contended that the merger of the United Church of Northern India (UCNI) with the Church of North India (CNI) was void ab initio, relying on the Supreme Court's 2013 judgment in Vinodkumar M Malaviya v. Maganlal Mangaldas Gameti.

As per the petition, the persons shown as members of the respondent UCNI on the MCA website, elected by Bishop Manoj Charan, are not members of the General Assembly of UCNI, and therefore "can't claim membership or directorship". The petition further alleged that Bishop Charan was aware of the "illegal merger".

The petition alleged, "The members aligned with Bishop Charan failed to vacate their directorial positions and instead proceeded to induct themselves into UCNITA... held themselves

out as directors of UCNI, dealing with and alienating various movable and immovable properties without authority of law."

The respondents, including UCNITA and its elected members, raised the preliminary objection of petitioners not being members of UCNITA. They submitted that following the 1970 merger and subsequent amendments to UCNITA's Memorandum and Articles of Association - upheld by the Company Law Board, the Bombay High Court, and the Supreme Court - only members of the Synod of the Church of North India were eligible to be members or directors of UCNITA.

Accepting the respondents' submissions, the tribunal held that the Supreme Court's ruling in Malaviya was limited to the merger involving one constituent church, the First District Church of Brethren, and did not declare the formation of the CNI or the merger of other churches illegal.

The bench further observed that UCNI and its General Assembly ceased to exist after the merger and that entities registered thereafter could not claim rights in UCNITA. It also took note of disputed filings before the Registrar of Companies and allegations of fraud relating to changes briefly reflected on the MCA portal in 2024.

Bishop Bijaya Nayak's contention

The petitioners had perpetrated acts of fraud, pursuant to which an FIR was registered at Gamdevi police station in 2024.

One of the petitioners, apprehending arrest in connection with the said proceedings, had filed an application for anticipatory bail before the Bombay Sessions Court, which was rejected. (Bishop Nayak served as the Moderator of the Church of North India from 2022)

₹630 cr tax unpaid: Notices to top 20

The BMC has slapped seizure notices on top 20 property tax defaulters owing Rs630 crore. The civic body warned that missed deadlines will trigger action under the Mumbai Municipal Corporation (MMC) Act, beginning with seizure and auction of movable assets and, if needed, the properties themselves. The defaulters include several leading real estate developers.

As per the BMC, the top property tax defaulters include Raghuvanshi Mills Ltd (Rs140.61 crore), M/s Rajhans Associates (Rs47.03 crore), M/s Ashapura Developers (Rs44.88 crore), Sumer Buildcorp Pvt Ltd (Rs39.30 crore), Sameer Bhojwani (K-West ward; Rs31.73 crore), DBS Realty with multiple dues ranging from Rs29.12 crore to Rs18.67 crore, Aamir Parks & Amusement Pvt Ltd (P South; Rs27.80 crore), SD Corporation (R-South; Rs21.43

crore), AR Jafar (D-ward; Rs21.03 crore), and Galaxy Corporation 10 Planet (H West; Rs20.23 crore).

The BMC has collected Rs5,426.81 crore in property tax between April 1, 2025, and February 4, 2026, around 73% of its Rs7,341 crore target for 2025-26. With Rs1,915 crore still to be recovered by March 31, the end of the financial year, the civic body is intensifying efforts to trace major defaulters.

A civic official said property tax must be paid within 90 days of assessment. Officials from the assessment and collection department follow up with owners, and if unpaid, a demand notice and a 21-day final notice are issued. Under MMC Act Sections 204-206, movable assets are first seized and auctioned; if recovery fails, the property itself may be auctioned. The cumulative outstanding dues dating back to 2010 have swelled to Rs22,000 crore, including 15 years of penalties.

20-yr-old held for smuggling ₹30L drugs

Mumbai Airport Customs have arrested a 20-year-old woman for allegedly smuggling drugs. The officers intercepted Suhana, a resident of Shivamogga, Karnataka, after she arrived from Bangkok on Sunday. Her trolley bag was found stuffed with 12 transparent vacuum-sealed packets.

The plastic packets contained 300gm of greenish coloured substance in lumps, alleged to be flowering or fruiting tops of the cannabis plant known as hydroponic weed (marijuana) valued at Rs30 lakh. In her statement, Suhana admitted to smuggling for money.

Officials said she revealed involvement of other persons, who are yet to be traced. The investigations in the case are at a very preliminary stage, and efforts are also being made to identify and apprehend key members of the drug cartel, said a Customs officer.
